Why don't we touch startup culture of USA?

This course is for entrepreneurship education with real field work, going to Boston and pitch your business plan to investors of USA. This is a rare opportunity to learn about world-class entrepreneurship by inviting Dr. Yasuhiro Yamakawa from Babson College, the most popular university in this field!

During the in-country program, students will create ideas and prototypes for their business in Japan. They will learn about business plans from Babson College educators and students, and improve the business plans they created in the early stages of the program.

For the abroad program, the students will travel to Boston to hold discussions with local people and finally pitch their business plan to investors at the Cambridge Innovation Center (CIC) in Boston.

2nd-year undergraduate students and above including master or doctor course students can join this course. This subject will be conducted entirely in "English".
