

Guidelines for the use of QREC Studio under countermeasures against new coronavirus infection

Following the measures taken by Kyushu University to combat the spread of the new coronavirus, the QREC Studio will operate according to the following guidelines during the Fall/Winter 2020 semester.

■ Restrictions on using the studio

- When entering the studio, please inform the QREC office that you will use it.
- When leaving the studio, please inform the QREC office that you will leave.
- Please take your temperature before entering the studio; if you have a fever of 37.5 degrees or higher, you will not be allowed to use the studio.
- Before using the workshop, please install the COVID-19 Contact-Confirming Application (COCOA). You can use the studio only if you have not been in contact with a person who has tested positive for the new coronavirus in the past 14 days.

■ Restriction of activities in the studio

- Please be sure to wear a mask when working in the studio.
 - The number of people who can work in the studio at the same time is limited to 4. (The maximum number of people at the time of reservation is 2.)
 - When working in the studio, please open the windows and make sure there is plenty of ventilation.
 - When working in the studio, please be careful not to get too close.
 - When entering or leaving the studio, please write down a record of your entry and exit.
 - Please wash and disinfect your hands when entering the studio.
- * After every time students use the QREC studio, the staff will ventilate and disinfect it.
